OPERATION FINANCIAL LITERACY (OFL)

To access OFL materials:

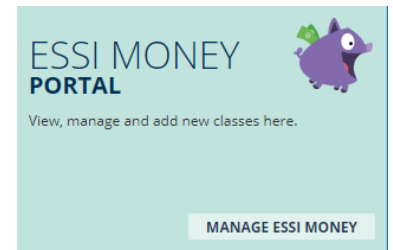

Setting up an ESSI Money game for each class is a quick and easy process.

Step 1:

[Login](#) to your Financial Basics Foundation account.

Click on the 'Manage ESSI Money' button in the ESSI Money spotlight.



Step 2:

Create a class by completing the 'ADD A NEW ESSI MONEY CLASS' form.

Ensure that you **choose the appropriate game type**, either 'ESSI MONEY' (basic game) or 'EASY MONEY PLUS' (advanced game).

Step 3:

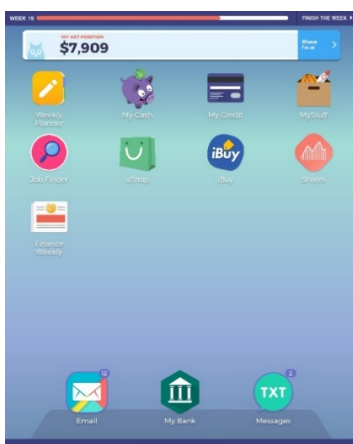
Students use the Game Link to register as a new user - using their school email as their username - or log in as an existing user. Once registered they can continue to use the same log in to access games for any class link in any subject. .

To view your Teacher Dashboard (includes class leaderboard, quiz results, diary entries and more):

Click on the 'VIEW CLASS' link to view your class scoreboard and student game activity.

Student results appear on the scoreboard after they complete 'Week 1' of the game. The scoreboard is refreshed and updated approximately every 15 minutes.
